Contact pulley and openers must be securely attached with belt before use. 2. Trolley connection into retaining slot as shown on page number 11. 3. Trolley against screwdriver, tighten nut ring by turning 1/4 turn with wrench on square end. 1. Install rail on top of section, as illustrated. 2. Remove foam packaging. 3. Raise opener onto stepladder; ensure ladder is tall enough for assistance if needed. 4. Open door fully. 5. Hang opener securely to structural supports; use concrete anchors and angled brackets in masonry. 6. Install door control at minimum height of 5 feet, away from moving parts. 7. Connect 24 Volt low voltage wires; disconnect all power before installation. 8. Wear protective gloves and eye protection when changing battery or working around it. 9. Attach emergency release rope with overhand knot; use only when garage door is closed. Before attempting any maintenance, turn off all power sources. Ensure the garage door is installed correctly and meets safety standards to avoid electrocution or fire hazards. Disconnect electricity before servicing the opener, which features a grounding plug for added safety. Comply with local electrical codes during installation.
